MT. WASHINGTON, NEW HAMPSHIRE HIKING TRIP

CALLING ALL HIKERS (AND GOLFERS AND SHOPPERS TOO !!)

September 8 – 12, 2019

As of this newsletter, I have 9 Members who have interest. Members can come for all five days, or can stay for fewer days.

SUGGESTED ITINERARY:

- September 8th - Drive in a carpool - 9 hours, 525 miles.
- September 9th – 11th – Three hikes – See Info Below
- September 12th – Return home

LODGING: Possibly rent a house depending on number of Members going. *Depending on the numbers we could stay at small motel, camping or large expensive hotel.*

HIKING:

- 1st day: hike Tuckerman Ravine Trail, the famous trail to summit, 5.8 miles roundtrip, all day hike.
 - 2nd day: hike Franconia Ridge/Falling Waters/Bridle Path trails, great hike, 9.0 miles roundtrip, all day hike.
 - 3rd day: hike Jewell Trail, return on Cog Railroad. Easiest hike and it's only one way.
- [All hikes are alpine starts with the exception of the Jewell Trail, so we don't have to rush and get out by dark] All are hiking only, no climbing.

OTHER ACTIVITIES:

The White Mountains are the hiking capital of the east. This trip is all about hiking and that will be our objective.

BUT, we could ride the Cog Railroad up and back from summit, or we could drive to the summit.

Train ride from North Conway through the mountains- approximately a 4 hour trip.

Golf at Sunday River (yes, one of our favor skiing resorts), a 35 minute drive.

Shopping in the very small towns.

Grocery shopping in Maine for lobster for everyone!!!

LEBANON SKI CLUB - TRIP/EVENT REGISTRATION FORM 2018/2019

1. TRIP/EVENT SIGN-UP AND PAYMENT

- A. Everyone participating in Club trips must be a member of the **Lebanon Ski and Sport Club, Inc.**, unless otherwise designated.
- B. Everyone participating in club trips must be at least 18 years of age, unless accompanied by a Parent/Legal Guardian.
- C. Registration for all club trips or events must include this registration form and the initial deposit. Deposits shall be made by check made payable to the **Lebanon Ski and Sport Club, Inc.**
- D. Everyone under 21 years of age must abide by all state laws governing alcoholic beverage consumption. Any individual under 21 years of age who consumes alcoholic beverages or any club member, who furnishes any individual under the age of 21 with alcoholic beverages, shall be prohibited from participating in any additional club trips. In addition, the Board may expel said individual(s) for violations of this policy.
- E. Trips will be filled as follows:
 - 1. Registrations will be accepted in the order they are received. Deposits, (**checks only**) and registration forms are to be given to the trip leader assigned to that trip. Trip Leader addresses will be listed in the monthly newsletter.
 - 2. The initial deposit amount and the schedule for the remaining payments will be stated in the official trip announcement. Payment schedules will also be listed in the monthly newsletter.
 - 3. The club makes reasonable efforts to pair members to fill rooms to meet the occupancy rate. However, due to the variety of room configurations, parties signing up for trips with less than required occupancy may incur additional charges to cover room costs not otherwise covered.
- F. **Lebanon Ski & Sports Club Inc. (LSSCI) reserves** the right to make any changes including, but not limited to: price, time, departure point, lodging, air flights, trip cancellations where such changes are in the best interest of *LSSCI* or are compelled by circumstances beyond *LSSCI's* control.

2. Participant Cancellation: Cancellation with full refund will be made if the vacancy created is filled at the time of the event. It is the responsibility of the participants to find a replacement, not the trip leader. If the vacancy is not filled, refunds will be made only for the portion of the deposit not required to cover fixed, non-refundable expenses incurred by the club. Cancellations fees will be determined on a trip-by-trip basis. Any trip refund is provided after the trip.
