UPDATES

I am hoping that those going on the trip to Killington are excited about getting out there to ski. Here are a few things to expect when you get there.

CHAIRLIFTS & GONDOLAS

The chairlifts and gondolas will be loaded in a way that allows for physical distancing. On all lifts, guests skiing and riding with their traveling party will be able to fill the chair or cabin up to 100% capacity; no other guests may join a traveling party. Single skiers and riders will ride by themselves on double chairs and triple chairs or with one other single on quads, the six-pack or gondolas. Singles may not choose to ride by themselves on these lifts. Masks covering the nose and mouth are required at all times in lift lines and while loading, riding and unloading lifts.

Physical distancing in lift queues occurs organically due to the length of skis and snowboards and guests will notice additional spacing measures, including extended maze designs, more lateral spacing and increased signage, to further ensure a consistent flow of appropriately spaced traffic.

LIFT TICKETS

Killington and Pico are now using RFID technology instead of paper lift tickets and scanners. There are no perforated barcodes to save as proof if a lift ticket is lost. ALL GUESTS should take a photo with their phone of the 20-digit number on the back of the RFID card. There is NO re-issuing of lift tickets, but the code could help you!

The Grand Hotel will have ski check but are NOT taking the boots. I will be receiving the tickets and will let everyone know my room number for pick up. I have been told that the restaurant is open for reservations. Some of the area restaurants are open by reservation only and some have take out and will deliver. Everyone should be able to pre -register prior to arriving. (more information to follow).

I know everyone has practiced forever with social distancing and wearing masks. Just remember to be safe and have a great time. The snow is waiting!!!!!

Our twenty-eight travelers are gearing up for the trip to Winter Park, Colorado. As we navigate these uncertain times, here are some guidelines presented by our hosts to make things easier.

ANOTHER

OPERATIONS

EMBRACE TIME OUTSIDE: Layer up and be prepared for a wonderful day in nature! For everyone's well-being, there will be limited indoor dining on-mountain. Skiers/riders will be able to use the restroom or purchase food to go, but indoor capacity will be very limited and guests are required to wear face masks inside. Guests are encouraged to bring snacks or have lunch at their condo. Please visit the <u>specific dining location pages</u> for more information on dining off-slope.

ACTIVITIES: Please purchase activities and tours online at least 48 hours in advance. Many tours and activities will still be operating including tubing, snowshoe tours, ski bike tours, ski and ride guides, uphill tours, and ice bumper cars. Night tour options will run on a limited basis and daytime and night snowcat tours will be private tours only. Check the activity web pages for specific requirements, additional information, and to book your adventure.

RENTALS & LESSONS: All rentals and lessons must be purchased online at least 48 hours in advance.

LIFT LOADING: Stay with your crew when loading and riding lifts, and maintain at least 6 feet of distance. Masks are required to be worn in line and while riding the lift. Lifts will be loaded at reduced capacity unless everyone is from the same group. The gondola will be loaded at a strict 50% capacity unless everyone is from the same group, and cabin windows must be kept open at all times.

LODGING: Guests are asked to social distance and wear masks, there will be increased scheduled cleaning of public spaces, and changes to amenities and services may occur. Amenities and additional housekeeping services will be limited and require 24-hour notice.

HOUSEKEEPING: There will be no daily housekeeping. Employees will only enter into rooms when guests have vacated or are in another room in the unit. Touch surfaces will be disinfected throughout the day, following CDC guidelines. Decorative pillows, blankets and other soft goods have been removed from units to assist in the mitigation of the virus spread. Guests will use the text concierge to request needed items like towels and linens, kitchen supplies, etc.

CONTACTLESS CHECK-IN: I have provided a cell phone number for each traveler's reservation for check in via Text Concierge. Guests will access their keys through a lock box or key code. Additionally, you can utilize the Text Concierge throughout your trip for additional service requests, limiting your need to utilize the front desk.

Full details are available on our website at <u>lebanonskiclub.com</u>. Each traveler will receive their balance due statement, if any, in a personal email. Last payment due by January 12, 2021.

A. Everyone participating in Club trips must be a current member of the LSSCI	INITIAL

- B. Everyone participating in Club trips must be at least 18 years of age, unless accompanied by a Parent/Legal Guardian.
- C. Registration for all Club trips involving overnight stays, payment, or common transportation, must include this registration form and the initial deposit. Deposits shall be made by check made payable to the **Lebanon Ski and Sport Club, Inc.**
- D. Everyone under 21 years of age must abide by all state laws governing alcoholic beverage consumption.  - 2. The initial deposit amount and the schedule for the remaining payments will be stated in the official trip announcement. Payment schedules will also be listed in the monthly newsletter.
 - 3. The Club makes reasonable efforts to pair members to fill rooms to meet the occupancy rate. However, due to the variety of room configurations, parties signing up for trips with less than required occupancy may incur additional charges to cover room costs not otherwise covered. INITIAL______
