MARK YOUR CALENDAR...... TAKE A HIKE......TAX DAY! SATURDAY, APRIL 15, 2023 1:00 pm at trailhead parking lot

SIEGRIST DAM/HIGH BRIDGE RESERVOIR, IN PINE GROVE TOWNSHIP SCHUYLKILL CO (443 to Old Forge Road. Just outside Lickdale....near Swatara State Park)

Take an afternoon trek into the wilderness with your hosts Brian and Dianne Bachman. Considered a moderately challenging route, hike this somewhat desolate, beautiful 4.1 loop around the reservoir. You'll encounter a shady "tunnel" created by groves of rhododendron and mountain laurel, cross Fishing Creek on a 20' long braided cable wire "bridge" not once, but twice! And hike up and down Sharp Mountain. At one point, we will end up on the tail end of the Stony Valley rail trail. The terrain can be rocky and rugged at times, so good hiking shoes are a must. Dogs are permitted but I wouldn't recommend it.

At the onset, is the historical landmark of Swatara Iron Furnace and Ironmaster's Mansion.....circa 1830. Who knew??!!

Expect the hike to take at least two hours. Prepare accordingly and dress in layers. You'll get approximately 13,000 steps in (if you're counting) and burn enough calories to eat at Moose's LZ afterward.

LATE SPRING CYCLING AND GOLFING ADVENTURE June 2 and 3, 2023

PLEASE NOTE: The entire block of 12 rooms at the Kittanning Plaza Hotel have been filled for the Club's bike ride along the Allegheny River in June. The Hotel booked the 13th room for another member. The trip leader, Christie Adams, has added another 5 rooms to the block. If you are interested in going on the trip, please reserve your room as soon as possible.

Dust off your bikes and join fellow club members for a weekend of biking along the Allegheny River on the scenic Armstrong Trail in western PA. We will be staying at the Kittanning Plaza Hotel which provides easy access to the trail as well as other activities in the area, such as golfing at the Lenape Heights Golf Resort. A block of 12 rooms have been reserved under "Lebanon Ski and Sport Club" for the nights of June 2nd and 3rd. There is a 2-night minimum for rooms in the block with a rate of \$120/night plus tax. Those interested in participating must contact the hotel to secure their room and make payment arrangements by May 5, 2023. Reservations for only one night will not be part of the block and will not qualify for the special rate. The Armstrong Trail is a rail trail that is 35.5 miles long. LEBANON SKI & SPORT CLUB, Inc. (LSSCI) - TRIP/EVENT REGISTRATION FORM 2022/2023 **1. TRIP/EVENT SIGN-UP AND PAYMENT**

A. Everyone participating in Club trips must be a current member of the **LSSCI INITIAL**

B. Everyone participating in club trips must be at least 18 years of age, unless accompanied by a Parent/Legal Guardian.

C. Registration for all club trips involving overnight stays, payment, or common transportation, must include this registration form and the initial deposit. Deposits shall be made by check made payable to the Lebanon Ski and Sport Club, Inc.

D. Everyone under 21 years of age must abide by all state laws governing alcoholic beverage consumption. Any individual under 21 years of age who consumes alcoholic beverages or any club member, who furnishes any individual under the age of 21 with alcoholic beverages, shall be prohibited from participating in any additional club trips. In addition, the Board may expel said individual(s) for violations of this policy.

E. Trips will be filled as follows:

1. Registrations will be accepted in the order they are received. Deposits and registration forms are to be given to the trip leader assigned to that trip. Trip Leader addresses will be listed in the monthly newsletter.

2. The initial deposit amount and the schedule for the remaining payments will be stated in the official trip announcement. Payment schedules will also be listed in the monthly newsletter.

3. The club makes reasonable efforts to pair members to fill rooms to meet the occupancy rate. However, due to the variety of room configurations, parties signing up for trips with less than required occupancy may incur additional charges to cover room costs not otherwise covered. **INITIAL_____**

F. Lebanon Ski & Sports Club Inc. (LSSCI) reserves the right to make any changes including, but not limited to: price, time, departure point, lodging, air flights, trip cancellations - where such changes are in the best interest of LSSCI or are compelled by circumstances beyond LSSCI's control. When it is beyond the clubs control (ie, weather, airlines etc) any cost incurred will be the responsibility of the participant, not the club. INITIAL

2. Participant Cancellation: Cancellation with full refund will be made if the vacancy created is filled at the time of the event. It is the responsibility of the participants to find a replacement, not the trip leader. If the vacancy is not filled, refunds will be made only for the portion of the deposit not required to cover fixed, non-refundable expenses incurred by the club. Cancellations fees will be determined on a trip-by-trip basis. Any trip refund is provided after the trip, **INITIAL**
