It has been over 20 years since the Lebanon Ski and Sports Club has increased its dues. As the Club is no longer sponsoring bus trips to Atlantic City, our Treasury has been slowly decreasing. "TAKE A HIKE......TAX DAY"!

We'll hike around the Lebanon Reservoir which is over 4 miles covering varied and uneven terrain of rocks and creeks.

Surrounded by State Game Lands, wildlife can be seen or heard and remnants of beaver activity can be found on trees by the waterfront.





The dam, on left, was completed in 1994 and has the capacity to hold back 1.2 billion gallons of water. The dam breast is 600' long and 125' high. It's also known as High Bridge Dam which is a reference to the railroad bridge, on right, that once stood for 90 years, 75' over Mill Creek before it was dismantled in 1950.



The Ironmaster's Mansion can be seen to the right of the trailhead. This and the Swatara Furnace make up part of the 200 acre Swatara Furnace Historic District c1830. Other structures include a stone dam breast, barn, stone foreman's house and stone worker's double house. This property was officially added The National Register of Historic Places in July 1992.

Little Pine State Park

Little Pine State Park will be the campground we are using for our fun filled biking adventure on the beautiful Pine Creek Rail Trail. The campground is located just 4 miles from Waterville which is along the Pine Creek.

We will be staying in a group tenting site #3 at the campground where we will be together. This site has a modern rest room facility with showers and flush toilets and picnic tables plus a fire ring.

Saturday morning we will journey to the Slate Run Trail Head to start our northern journey with some members of the Lebanon Ski Club. We will ride as far as everyone is comfortable riding and stop back and a have a late lunch at the Manor in Slate Run. Some possibilities would be riding to Blackwell (21 mile round trip) or to Tiadaghton (37 mile round trip).

Sunday morning we will drive to the Waterville trail head and ride south again as far as we feel comfortable and can dine at the Waterville Hotel when we return. The trail ends in Jersey Shore which would be a 21 mile round trip.

I encourage you to bring activities along for enjoyment at the campground such as corn hole, lawn darts etc. Check in is 3:00 PM Friday the 19th and check out is Sunday the 21st by 3:00 PM. We will be staying at the Kittanning Plaza Hotel which provides easy access to the trail as well as other activities in the area, such as golfing at the Lenape Heights Golf Resort. LEBANON SKI & SPORT CLUB, Inc (LSSCI) - TRIP/EVENT REGISTRATION FORM 2023/2024 **1. TRIP/EVENT SIGN-UP AND PAYMENT**

A. Everyone participating in Club trips must be a current member of the **LSSCI INITIAL**

B. Everyone participating in club trips must be at least 18 years of age, unless accompanied by a Parent/Legal Guardian.

C. Registration for all club trips involving overnight stays, payment, or common transportation, must include this registration form and the initial deposit. Deposits shall be made by check made payable to the Lebanon Ski and Sport Club, Inc.

D. Everyone under 21 years of age must abide by all state laws governing alcoholic beverage consumption. Any individual under 21 years of age who consumes alcoholic beverages or any club member, who furnishes any individual under the age of 21 with alcoholic beverages, shall be prohibited from participating in any additional club trips. In addition, the Board may expel said individual(s) for violations of this policy.

E. Trips will be filled as follows:

1. Registrations will be accepted in the order they are received. Deposits and registration forms are to be given to the trip leader assigned to that trip. Trip Leader addresses will be listed in the monthly newsletter.

2. The initial deposit amount and the schedule for the remaining payments will be stated in the official trip announcement. Payment schedules will also be listed in the monthly newsletter.

3. The club makes reasonable efforts to pair members to fill rooms to meet the occupancy rate. However, due to the variety of room configurations, parties signing up for trips with less than required occupancy may incur additional charges to cover room costs not otherwise covered. INITIAL_____

(LSSCI) reserves the right to make any changes including, but not limited to: price, time, departure point, lodging, air flights, trip cancellations - where such changes are in the best interest of LSSCI or are compelled by circumstances beyond LSSCI's control. 2. Participant Cancellation: Cancellation with full refund will be made if the vacancy created is filled at the time of the event.
