COMMITTEE REPORTS

**TRIP OVERSIGHT**-Anne Shutter reported on the cost to go to Snowmass, CO. Too expensive at \$2799pp/2person-1bedroom;\$2514pp/4people-2bedroom; \$2499pp/6people-3bedroom includes airfare and 5 day lift tickets.
