
The election will take place at the March meeting, either for the entire slate of officers, or calling for a vote for individual positions if there are multiple nominees. The Past President will conduct the elections.

- C. Registration for all club trips involving overnight stays, payment, or common transportation, must include this registration form and the initial deposit. Deposits shall be made by check made payable to the **Lebanon Ski and Sport Club, Inc.**
- D. Everyone under 21 years of age must abide by all state laws governing alcoholic beverage consumption.
