3) One Western trip was suggested due the inability to adequately fill two trips. A suggestion from the group was Aspen/Snowmass in 2025. It is an Ikon pass mountain, though.

4) Ideas and trip leaders for Spring/Summer outings. These involved but not limited to joining the Tour de Lebanon Valley (2nd Saturday in June); joining the Sojourn down the Swatara

Creek in early May; Biking the Schuylkill River Trail May/June; Gettysburg Battlefield tour on bike with private guide in September.
