

Lebanon Ski and Sport Club
General Membership Meeting

November 11, 2025

President Chris Riegel called the meeting to order at 7:31 pm. There were 28 members present and 2 guests in attendance.

TREASURER REPORT

Tom Jannett stated the beginning balance was \$8,369.61. We had receipts of \$21,784.00 and expenses of \$264.55 leaving us an ending balance of \$29,889.06. On a motion by Wayne Wampler and a 2nd by Kevin Yeagley the report was accepted.

SECRETARY REPORT

Minutes of the October 14, 2025 meeting were posted on the club website. They were accepted on a motion by Anne Shutter and 2nd by Jack Billmyer.

MEMBERSHIP REPORT

Deb Binkley reported we have 86 paid members.

GUEST SPEAKER

Linda Billmeyer introduced Dr Carol Weber and her assistant Eileen McCormick from Madden & Gilbert Physical Therapy. She gave an informative presentation on concussion protocol. She used a True/False test to compare how much we knew before the lecture and how our understanding of concussions changed afterwards. She also used a printed “fill-in-the-blanks” sheet to help us understand that a concussion is a mild traumatic brain injury that causes chemical changes and disruption of brain cell communication.

TRIPS

- 1) Elk Mt. – Leader Ron Birch reports 4 condos are taken. He does not have the room rates established yet. Pay cash when you go. He reminded everyone to fill out the clubs trip forms for this trip.
- 2) Copper Mountain, Colorado – Leader Heidi Allison reports 28 people signed up. There has been a price increase of over 30% to the lift tickets since the trip was initially booked so there will be a slight increase to each member to compensate for this. The day trip to Arapaho Basin will cost \$155 which includes the transportation to A-Basin and a one day lift ticket. Each member should contact Heidi to decide how many days they wish to ski Copper and if they are going to A-Basin and she can determine your individual cost accordingly.

- 3) Sunday River, Maine – Leader Chris Riegel states 17 people committed. Final payment will be due by our December meeting.
- 4) Bolton Valley, Vermont – Trip leader Tom Jannett states 10 people are committed. Need 28 people minimum for the bus. Next payment is due November 21. So time is short. Some discussion about using a smaller bus or making this a self-drive trip or cancelling the whole trip. Will cost money if cancel trip.
- 5) Taos, New Mexico – February 27-March 6, 2027.

Next meeting of the ski club will be our Christmas party on December 9, 2025. Can gather around 6pm with appetizers and dinner will be around 7pm. There will be 50/50 raffle and at least 2 games. Members to be charged \$10/person and \$15/person for non-members.
