TREASURER REPORT

Tom Jannett stated that our beginning balance was \$48,996.18. We had a total receipts of \$11,073.00 and total expenses of \$37,286.75 leaving an ending balance of \$22,782.43. On a motion by Jack Billmyer and a second by Anne Shutter the report was accepted.

SECRETARY REPORT

Minutes of the December 9, 2025 meeting as presented by Fred Johnson and posted on the club website by Deb Bemederfer were accepted on a motion by Jim Spangler and a 2nd by Ceylon Leitzel.

MEMBERSHIP REPORT

Deb Binkley reported the club has 93 members as of tonight. She also stated that the Lebanon Rescue Mission wished to thank the club members for their donations totalling 210 lbs of food items given to the Mission.

GUEST SPEAKER

Jim Mulligan from Bouquet, Mulligan, DiMaio spoke to the members about new advances in eyewear. He mentioned their practice is the official eye specialists for the Hershey Bears hockey club. He first showed a new type of ski goggle in which you can rapidly change the lens from a full light tinted one to one which is much more suited for low light/cloudy conditions using the same goggle frame. He then presented a pair of glasses that with AI technology can take pictures and video recording with a simple switch on the glasses frame. The glasses can also translate 4 different languages to English and with verbal commands will read a book and translate the book into English. This can be especially helpful for senior citizens who are unable to read on their own due to poor eyesight. At the end of his presentation he gave a small ski related 9 question quiz. Ceylon Leitzel was awarded the prize for having the most correct answers.

TRIPS

Elk Mt- Ron Birch explained that he would be at the main lodge on Wednesday January 21st at 8:30 am to hand out lift tickets to everyone.
