

LEBANON SKI and SPORT CLUB

Board Meeting

May 12, 2026 via Zoom

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm by President Chris Riegel

In attendance: Chris Riegel, Jeff Sterner, Linda Billmyer, Tom Jannett, Fred Johnson, Deb Binkley, Deb Bemederfer, Anne Shutter.

The meeting minutes of the last Board meeting on March 31st were approved on a motion by Deb Binkley and a 2nd by Deb Bemederfer.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

TREASURER – Tom Jannett sent a report stating the club had a beginning balance of \$9,441.19 on April 1st. Total receipts for the month were \$9,060.00 with total expenses being \$8,200.00. This left the club with a balance of \$10,301.19 on April 30th.

A discussion ensued as to whether or not the club should pursue getting a credit card for the club. At present the bank has a debit card for Tom Jannett (treasurer) and Chris Riegel (president). The bank would also issue one to the immediate past president if he so desired but Jack does not have one at this time. After extended discussion on a motion by Fred Johnson and a 2nd by Jeff Sterner it was approved for the club not to pursue credit cards and stay with just the debit cards.

TRIP OVERSIGHT

Elk Mountain – After group suggestions it was decided Jeff Sterner will present to the trip leader (Ron Birch), three possible dates. January 12,13 & 14 OR February 24,25 & 26 OR March 15,16 & 17 2027. The Board will garner feedback from Ron as to which might work best.

Taos, NM – Feb 27- March 6, 2027

Chris Riegel stated he has 9 people signed up so far. Would need 10 members to get an airline group rate.

Sun Valley, ID. – Feb 6- Feb 13, 2027

Jeff Sterner reported that 20 people have already signed up. As of this date all seems well aligned for this trip.

Loon, NH. – This would be a self-drive trip with the expectation that most members would drive up Sunday January 24th and leave Friday January 29th with 4 days of skiing and 5 nights

lodging. The lodging being looked at is The Mountain Club which would be a ski in/ski out resort. Cost is approximately \$590 for a hotel room which includes 5 breakfasts, Lift tickets would be approximately \$60-70/day for an approximate total of \$900 final cost for the trip. Bretton Woods is close by and some members may wish to spend a day or 2 skiing there although it is not an Ikon resort. On a motion by Jeff Sterner and a 2nd by Deb Bemederfer the Board unanimously approved having Jeff prepare a package for a Loon trip. The Board also approved having Anne Shutter be the trip leader on a motion by Jeff Sterner and a 2nd by Chris Riegel.

MEMBERSHIP - Deb Binkley reports we have 57 members as of this date.

SOCIAL COORDINATOR

The club picnic is scheduled for August 29th. Anne Shutter discussed the Nissley Wine Concerts. After a general discussion it was agreed the club will try for the August 22nd date with The Uptown Band.

Lords of 52nd Street is sold out.

Bronx Wanders has 3 tickets left.

OLD BUSINESS

Marketing: Chris Riegel will have a table promoting the ski club at his church gathering in Myerstown this coming Saturday.

NEW BUSINESS

Jeff Sterner asked about planning for any 2028 ski trips. After multiple suggestions and a general discussion it was agreed that he should investigate Big Sky, Montana, some destination in Utah, and possibly one in Canada.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:58 pm on a motion by Anne Shutter and a 2nd by Fred Johnson
